10-DAY DEVOTIONAL

DAY ONE THE FOUNDATION OF A LEGACY

SCRIPTURE: PSALM 90:12

"Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom."

DEVOTION:

Leaving a lasting legacy starts with a humble acknowledgment of the limited time we have here on this earth. In the rush of our everyday lives, we often bypass thoughts on the brevity of our existence. Scripture says "Our life is like a vapor" (James 4:14). SCRIPTURE: PSALM 145:4

SCRIPTURE: ZECHARIAH 4:10A

"Do not despise these small beginnings, for the Lord rejoices to see the work begin..."

DEVOTION:

DAY FOUR A LEGACY OF LOVE

SCRIPTURE: 1 CORINTHIANS 13:13

"And now these three remain: faith, hope, and love. But the greatest of these is love."

DEVOTION:

A legacy built on love has the power to transcend generations. Love is the foundation of all meaningful relationships and lasting impact. Today, let's focus on nurturing our relationships, showing compassion, and even extending forgiveness. By doing so, we contribute to a legacy of love that will be remembered long after we are gone. TODAY'S PRAYER:

DAY FIVE INVESTING IN OTHERS

SCRIPTURE: PROVERBS 22:6

SCRIPTURE: PROVERBS 13:20

"Walk with the wise and become wise, for a companion of fools suffers harm."

DEVOTION:

Today, consider the importance of surrounding yourself with wise and godly individuals. SCRIPTURE: PROVERBS 20:7

DAY NINE AN ETERNAL IMPACT

SCRIPTURE: MATTHEW 6:19-21

"Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth... but store up for yourselves treasures in heaven. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

DEVOTION:

Today, remember that the legacy we leave on Earth is connected to our ETERNAL impact. Material possessions fade, but the investments we make in the lives of others and our relationship with God have everlasting significance. SCRIPTURE: 2 CORINTHIANS 4:18

"So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen; since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal."

DEVOTION:
